Explore CUHK Campus	New Asia College 新亞書院 Pavilion of Harmony 「合一亭」	合一亭於2003年12月12日正式揭幕,由伍宗琳女士 贊助、前中大建築系陳惠基教授設計而成。中大前校 長、新亞書院前院長金耀基教授曾讚譽其水天一色的 景緻為「香港第二景」。
		合一亭位處學思樓與知行樓之間,亭身靠近學思樓, 一面靠牆,一面臨空,頂部透明,旁植竹樹,另有斜 行步道在側。步道外牆鐫刻了錢穆先生於 1990 年 96 歲時所寫之〈天人合一論〉,時任院長梁秉中教授正 是受此文啟發而籌建合一亭。〈天人合一論〉墨寶由 中大藝術系前系主任李潤桓教授所書;另外還鐫有由 中大藝術系唐錦騰教授設計雕刻的「天人合一」印 章。呈新月形的水池旁植有大榕樹,「一池清水,二 樹半抱」。
		<< 資料來源:新亞書院>> Sponsored by Ms. Dora Wu and designed by Prof. Freeman Chan from the Department of Architecture, CUHK, the Pavilion of Harmony was officially opened on 12 December 2003. Prof. Ambrose King, Former Vice Chancellor of CUHK and Former New Asia College Head, once praised the harmonious scenery as "The Second Best View in Hong Kong". Located between two student hostels Xuesi Hall and Chih Hsing Hall, one side of the Pavilion rests against a wall while another opens up to a vast space. Decorated with a glass canopy and bamboo on the side, it is connected to an accessible walkway. Engraved on a long metal plaque along the walkway is what inspired then College Head Prof. Leung Ping Chung to construct the Pavilion - Mr. Chien Mu's "The Theory of the Union of Man and Nature", written in 1996 when he was 96 years old. The calligraphy is by Prof. Lee Wun Yoon, Former Chairperson of the Department of Fine Arts, CUHK. The Seal of the Union of Man and Nature, designed by Prof. TONG Kam Tang Vincent from the Department of Fine Arts, CUHK, is also displayed. A big banyan tree was planted next to the crescent-shaped pool.

	The University Mall 林蔭大道	中大林蔭大道,又名「百萬大道」
		百萬大道位於大學圖書館與科學館之間。長260呎, 闊115呎,面積近3萬平方呎的大道寬敞廣大,在每 年大學畢業典禮上容納數以千計的畢業生。
		Between the University Library and the Science Centre is the most famous walkway on campus, the University Mall (林蔭大道). The Mall was originally designed to allow all students to "meet, rub shoulders, and exchange ideas".
re CUHN Campus		One saying is that the "Million Boulevard" is floored with millions of crafted tiles. Although the walkway, occupying an extensive area of open space between the University Library and the Science Centre, can accommodate thousands of participating guests in the University's annual congregations, it seems exaggerated to claim that millions of tiles were used in its construction as its floor area is just 29,900 sq ft (260 ft (L) x 115 ft (W)).
Explore	University Science Centre "Rice Cooker" 中大「飯煲」	<b>中大「飯煲」</b> 「飯煲」指的其實就是科學館中央的演講大樓,科學 館採用獨特的圓形設計,面向百萬大道之外牆更嵌有 巨型校徽,外型看來就像一只電飯煲,因此被冠以 「飯煲」之名。「飯煲底」多年來也是各位畢業生拍 照的必到之處,久而久之成為了校園的不二標記。直 到今天,這個遙望百萬大道盡頭的中大校徽仍見證每 位莘莘學子的成長片段。

EXPIORE CURN (	Lake Ad Excellentiam 未圓湖	境與文化氣息。 「未圓」蘊含「仍未圓滿,須繼續力求圓滿」之意, 呼應校訓「止於至善」以圓滿為永恆理想之自強不息 精神與開放精神,其義可與校訓互釋互明。 未圓湖不是圓形的,形狀不規則而帶若干彎角。「未 圓」隱指世事難常圓滿,永遠無法達到盡善盡美的境 界。因此大家更應當努力不懈,對完美心嚮往之,力 臻至善。
		Lake Ad Excellentiam (Weiyuan Lake), formerly known as the Lily Pond, is the most famous landmark of Chung Chi College. It echoes Chung Chi College's motto, "In Pursuit of Excellence". In the mid-1990s, a major renovation was executed with two bridges newly built across the Lake. The Crooked Bridge on the east and the Arched Bridge on the west signify the ups and downs and twists and turns in life respectively. However, one is always able to cross the bridge, and arrive at the other side. Philosophy Path, the trail hugging the shoreline of the Lake, leads one to contemplate on life as philosophers do. You may find on the slope close-by a topiary work of the College' s Motto, "In Pursuit of Excellence 止於至善".
